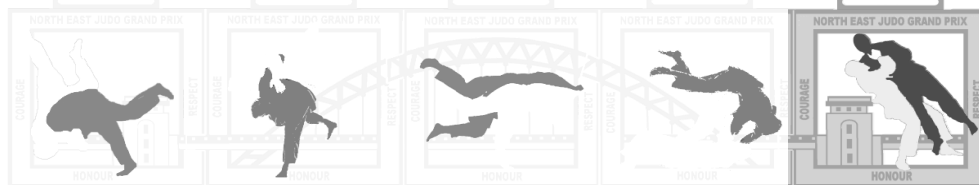


# North East Judo Grand Prix Competition

	This is a joint venture event between local BJA, BJC and Bushido Zazen clubs, All students who register for the competition will be entered onto a leaderboard and will collate points from all five Grand Prix Events held this year. All students will be invited to an end of year presentation event to be held in Jan20. 3 Contest mats will be in use during the day.

<b>Event A:</b>	<b>Boys and Girls 5 to 9 years</b> This event shall be run under current BJA competition rules There will be no armlocks or strangles, drop knee or sacrifice throws. Groups of 3 and 4 will be pools, 5 or more will be Knockout with Repechage. Groups less than 3 will be merged with the next category.

<b>Categories:</b>	Boys - u21, u24, u27, u30, u34, u38, over 38kg Girls - u22, u25, u28, u32, u36, over 36kg
<b>Event B:</b>	<b>Boys and Girls 10 to 15 years</b> This event shall be run under current BJA competition rules There will be no armlocks or strangles, Groups of 3 and 4 will be pools, 5 or more will be Knockout with Repechage. Groups less than 3 will be merged with the next category.
<b>Weigh in:</b>	10 to 15 year Girls 10.00 to 10:30am, 10 to 15 year Boys 11:00 to 11:30am
<b>Categories:</b>	Boys - u30, u34, u38, u42, u46, u50, u55, u60, u66, Over 66kg Girls - u32, u36, u40, u44, u48, u52, u57, u63kg, Over 63kg
<b>Closing Date:</b>	Saturday 12th October or when entry limit of 275 is reached

No club will be allowed more than 40 Entries. Competitors will be added to the leaderboard allocated to the club identified on their Licence.
